Trade Essentials Whiteboard PB & MR PB is manufactured by laminating sheets of paper impregnated with melamine resin to both sides of either Laminex particleboard or moisture resistant particleboard under heat and pressure. The resin on the top surface of the paper cures, forming a tough, stain resistant finish.

Conditions of use

Trade Essentials Whiteboard PB & MR PB is:

- not intended for exterior use
- not intended for use in high humidity or wet applications such as saunas or shower/wash down rooms
- not intended that Trade Essentials Whiteboard PB & MR PB products get wet. As such the product must not be used in an external location. When used where accidental water spill can occur, all surfaces must be suitably sealed. Special care must be taken at the intersection of panels and accessories (hardware and edging etc.) to ensure moisture cannot penetrate the substrate
- not fire rated as part of a fire protected boundary or fire wall
